While there it was great to have my Uncle Jim and Aunt Carolyn along with my cousin Amy and her family and another cousin Hannah come to one of the evening services. They live about thirty minutes from the church. After the Conference we got to spend a couple of days with them in their home, it was a great time.

This last Sunday we finished a Missions Conference at Bible Baptist Church in Jacksonville, Arkansas with Pastor Files. We had a great week. Pastor Allison from Alabama was the main speaker for the week. All the missionaries that were in the Missions Conference were able to talk to the students in the Christian school they have on Thursday and Friday of the Missions Conference. Also the missionary men had the opportunity to preach in their college chapel on Friday. Sunday night ended the Missions Conference with the church committing over \$242,000.00 towards Faith Promise up from last year's goal and that Sunday night the church took us and the other two new missionary families on for monthly financial support. We praise God for that. It was a great encouragement. We also enjoyed getting to know and fellowship with the people there.
