The work is going well here in Uruguay. Last week we had family camp at the camp in La Tuna. There were about thirty in attendance with four churches represented. The guest speaker was a pastor from Buenos Aires, Argentina. It was a great week filled with morning Bible classes for the men and women, activities and games in the afternoon and a preaching service in the evening. Abigail and Miriam sang a special



on Tuesday evening and I had the opportunity to give the devotional on Wednesday morning. The Lord really blessed the week. We were excited to have been able to take part in this week.

We have some great news to share about our visa status. We have been trying since we moved here almost two years ago to get residency or some other type of visa. Since residency was not possible because the government is making it almost impossible for missionaries to get we have been trying to obtain another type of visa for some time now. Our family has joined up with two other missionary families here in Uruguay trying to get a certain type of visa. We have been in the process for almost a year now and recently have received word from the lawyer that everything has been approved and he will be turning all of our passports in to the government to get stamped with the visa on the 7th of April. It has been a long process, but we praise the Lord it is almost over. This visa will allow us to stay in the country without having to leave every three months.
