Dear Pastor and Praying Church,

May-June 2016

Greetings from Uruguay! It is autumn here and getting colder every day. On Sundays I am preaching through the book of Acts. Recently I started chapter three where Peter and John came across the lame man that was lying at the gate of the Temple. When he asked alms of Peter and John, Peter's response was this: "**Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk.**" **Acts 3:6.** It reminded me that every day we come across people that need help whether they are asking for money or something else. We may not always be able to help them financially or physically, but there is another way we can help them. We can give them the Gospel. We can share with them our testimony and how God has changed our lives and share with them that He can do the same for them as well.

A couple of things have taken place since our last prayer letter. First the missionaries we have been working with since August left mid May to begin their furlough. What an opportunity we have before us as we oversee the work here. Please pray for us that God will guide us and give us wisdom as we continue the work here.

The second thing that has taken place since our last prayer letter is our church has moved locations. The church is now renting a house on the other side of town. It has about the same amount of space as our other place, but we are now out of the Cisler's house, which is something the church has been praying about for some time now. Please pray that the Lord will use us in the new location and that we will see many people come to church and see many souls saved. We still have some work to do on the building, but we are already able to meet there and have been for a few weeks.

Thank you for your prayers and financial support for our family. We do covet your prayers. One personal prayer request is for our visas. While our Passports were stamped months ago showing we are legal to be in the country, we are still waiting on our visa cards, which makes it official that we can be here. Without our visa cards it is impossible for us to leave the country. One missionary family recently had some problems flying out of the country because of this issue. Our escribana has dropped the ball about four times now with getting the cards for us and he is the only one we know that can help us with this. This has been an on going problem now for about a year. I ask that you pray that our escribana will get our visa cards done for us. We have less than eight months before we leave for furlough.

As I have mentioned in our previous letters we are planning our first furlough for January 2017. We would love to come and give a report to your church either for a service or a Missions Conference.
