This Thanksgiving we were able to celebrate with our teammates here in Rocha. We celebrated on Friday instead of Thursday, and had a great day. Living in a foreign country you don't have all the conveniences that you would have in the States. Some things you just have to improvise. Erika made a pumpkin pie from scratch using a traditional type of squash found here than the traditional pumpkin, it came out great. We were blessed to have everything we needed.

The week after Thanksgiving Lydia came down with a sickness. What we thought was her cutting a tooth turned out to be an internal infection, and it has affected her ears and throat as well as causing sores on the inside of her mouth. She basically cried for three days because her mouth was hurting her so much. She wouldn't eat or drink hardly anything during those days. We had to force her to drink so she didn't dehydrate. As I write this prayer letter several days after she got the infection, this is the first day she seems like she is feeling a little bit better and drinking on her own. Please pray for her to get better. The doctor said it could take a week or so for the infection to go away with the antibiotics.

The work here in Rocha is going great. God is blessing. We have seen two visitors come off and on for the last month. They both saw the church sign as they were driving by and have a desire to learn more about God. Please pray for their salvation.

Christmas Sunday the children are putting on a Christmas program. We have invited the children in the area to come and get involved. We are hoping to use this as an opportunity to get into the homes of the children and be able to see their parents come to church.
