Greeting from sunny Uruguay! The weather has finally warmed up here after a cold and long winter. It has been in the 80's this week but is expected to be close to 90 next week. Praise the Lord for the warm weather! It is also hard to believe that this is our final prayer letter for 2016. The year seems to have flown by.

In October I had the opportunity to attend the Fundamentalismo in Buenos Aires. It is a yearly meeting where pastors and missionaries from Chile, Argentina, Paraguay and Uruguay get together for fellowship, encouragement and preaching from the Word of God. There were about a hundred or so in attendance this year. For me it was a time not only to be encouraged and sit under the preaching, but also to be able to meet and get to know other national pastors and missionaries from South America.

While there, I had the opportunity to meet a Buenos Aires police officer. Every morning he was standing guard patrolling a certain street in downtown Buenos Aires when I would be heading out to go to the meeting. The first morning as I was walking by he was talking out loud that someone had just tried to speak to him in English, but he had no idea what he said. I mentioned that I spoke English in passing and then he wanted find out more about me-where I was from and why I was there in Buenos Aires. This opened up the door for me to talk to him about why we were living here in Uruguay and witness to him. Every morning for the next two days I would stop and talk with him for a few minutes. Thankful for the opportunity to be able to meet him and witness to him.



At the end of October we had a church wide family picnic at the church. We grilled chorizos, hamburgers, and hot dogs for the kids. Each family brought a salad or a desert. It was a great time of fun, food and fellowship.

The last Saturday of November my family and I had the opportunity to help out a national pastor and his church in the next town over from us in the city of La Paloma. They had a day set aside to pass out tracts to the surrounding area around the church. We passed out tracts for about two hours and were able to talk to many people and several said they would visit the church. Please pray for Pastor Jorge and his wife Claudia and Iglesia Bautista el Faro.

Thank you for your continued prayers and financial support for the work here in Uruguay and for our family. Don't forget we are planning our first furlough to start in January of 2017.
